

Recyclemania Contest



Lehigh is participating in the national Recyclemania competition between February 4 and March 31! Recyclemania is a friendly 8-week waste diversion and recycling competition against colleges and universities to promote waste reduction and recycling activities in campus communities. During this competition, Lehigh will report the amount of recycling and trash collected each week and will in turn be ranked in various categories against other schools. This is the sixth year that Lehigh will be participating in this tournament.

THIS YEAR'S GOAL

- Raise awareness among Lehigh faculty, staff, and students about what is and isn't recyclable at Lehigh and how to reduce waste generation.
- Increase the average waste diversion rate by AT LEAST 5 percent compared to the pre-competition waste diversion rate.

HOW CAN YOU HELP?

- Learn what is and isn't recyclable at Lehigh! Here is a trash sign and recycling sign for your bins.
- Recycle and reduce your waste generation as much as possible during this competition...and everyday!

- Applications are now open for ComSciCon 2018, the 6th annual Communicating Science workshop, to be held in Boston, MA on June 14-16th 2017. Graduate students at U.S. and Canadian institutions in all fields of science, technology, engineering, health, mathematics, and related fields are encouraged to apply. The application will close on March 1st.

- Participants will build the communication skills that scientists and other technical professionals need to express complex ideas to the general public, experts in other fields, and their peers. In additional to panel discussions (on topics such as Creative Storytelling, Science Journalism, Diversity/Inclusivity, and a Case Study on Scicomm in Medicine), ample time is allotted for networking with science communication experts and developing science outreach collaborations with fellow graduate students.




GRADUATE CULTURAL BREAKFAST HOSTS WANTED:
