- PSECU is a credit union
- We are a financial institution, if the credit union makes a profit, then those profits go back to the members that belong to the unit.
- Opened in March 2018, located on Mountaintop in Building C
- If you become a member, you get:
 - Free checking
 - No minimum balance
 - No monthly fee
 - If you use the debit card in another ATM, and youg et a surcharge, we reimburse you
 - You can also get free checks
 - Free credit scores
- No fee to join
- If you have a job where you earn \$300 or more, you will get a credit of \$150 for opening an account
 - Have checking and savings accounts
- On campus location-answers questions
 - Help with financial services
 - Provides workshops about credit, budgeting, applying for a loan, etc, can offer those services
 - Also hire students on campus as paid interns





- There is a QR code and Sign up link on the flyer, find the people at the end of the meeting






