DHS Proposal ICEB-2019-0006

- •What's being proposed?
 - o Currently: non-immigrant visitors to US can stay for a period of time known as duration of stay (D/S) which is basically program length for school or job (+ time to arrange travel)
 - o Proposed: setting limit of stay to a period of time (2 or 4 years) with the ability for students to apply for extensions
- •Who does it impact?
 - o F, J, and I visa holders from any country
- •How to impact change?
 - oComments submitted online here by October 26th 2020
- •What are important concerns?
 - oThe extension process:
- ■Not a lot of proposed structure to handle higher demand
- ■4 years isn't enough for most PhDs and extension has requirements, not guaranteed
 - o Eligibility of certain "category" of people for shorter approved stays
- ■Most of list composed of countries with >10% overstay rate (link)
