- Carter's office presents to government officials the interests of Lehigh community. They bring in the legislative force to further the interests of the community in higher education policy, student financial aid, immigration and international students affairs, campus safety issues, Title IX and sexual assault cases.
- Current bills that Carter's office is looking over are related to innovation and
 competitiveness issues in graduate studies, how certain fields are funded at
 federal level and industry, NSF graduate students mental health bill, an
 expansion of STEM mentorship program which will be an opportunity for more
 mentorship across the country.

Launching Over Winter Break...

- First iteration of the Resource Series (this is an evolving project, but expect it to roll out before the start of the Spring Semester)
- Evolving Concern Survey
 - Will launch shortly! [In the construction phase → pilot phase]
 - This will primarily be **broad** and will have sub-sections regarding pressing issues as they arise
 - Current topics you'd like to see included?
- CLUBS: Expect us to set up a meeting with a club representative to review the fiscal governance either over Winter Break or at the start of the Spring semester
 - Topics that students would see included in the evolving Concern Survey:
 - Food Security
 - Healthcare for dependents
 - Adequate funding and cost of living analysis for graduate students
 - Parking and transportation
 - Generally health insurance and its cost
 - Childcare support
 - Accessibility issues

- Pictures will be due at the beginning of the Spring semester






End of Semester Check-in

- As the fall semester wraps up, it's important to check in regarding any developing or previously existing challenges grads are facing.
- Soliciting feedback:
 - What concerns were brought to light this semester?
 - Do you have any concerns as we transition to the spring?

- From the mid-survey, students mentioned needing more social life/stress-relief, shorter messaging from administration.
- Students reported that unvaccinated staff members who are not granted exemption are continuing to work on campus which is raising concerns for the students and putting them at risk. Kathleen will look into this to make sure the information relayed is correct and acted upon.
- Joan will take up with CRT regarding a potential Covid booster clinic on campus, their plans for entry/exit testing for Spring semester and Isolation protocol. She will ask clarification on if students need to upload the booster vaccination information to the HWC portal.




University Diversity, Inclusion, & Equity Strategic Plan




The University has decided that a COVID vaccine will be required this fall for all Lehigh undergraduate and graduate students participating in on-campus programs and activities. More information can be found here.






